Message from the Chairman

am pleased to report that Eagle Community Credit Union (Eagle) experienced \$23M growth in total assets in 2021. Loans grew by \$38M, predominately in the mobile home and vehicle loan sectors The Credit Union had a net income of \$2.4M for the year, largely a result of an increase in loan interest income and a well-managed collections team, the highest net income total in 21 years. 2021 ended with a net worth of 8.98% of assets which is considered "well capitalized" by state and federal regulatory agencies.

Like many of us, the Credit Union faced continuing challenges because of the COVID pandemic in 2021. Member growth remained curtailed as the Credit Union was unable to maintain consistent lines of communication within

our select employee groups. I am proud of the Credit Union, the Eagle team, and our Members for getting through this together. Through the cooperative spirit of Eagle Community Credit Union, we accomplished the following last year:

- Increased staff from 84 to 92.5 FTE to better assist Members.
- Replaced all Eagle ATMs with new state-of-the-art machines to improve accessibility.
- Updated our call center phone system to expand our capabilities, increase licenses, and provide new features to improve our call center's ability.
- Upgraded our technology infrastructure to expand our capabilities and service potential.
- Engaged our local community through financial

education and community partnerships.

- Created new partnerships with non-profits, such as, Latino Health Access, that serve the underserved communities in Orange County.
- The Credit Union's Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion committee identified several opportunities to assist our community.
- Significant growth in mobile and manufactured home loans, providing opportunities to Members in communities with limited options.
- Increased the minimum wage to \$20 per hour for all team members.
- Increased the Credit Union's portion of health benefits for the team members and their families.

In 2022, we will continue our efforts to enhance the value of your Membership. To this end, we have the following exciting and important initiatives underway to serve our Members:

- Continual improvement of the Credit Union's technology infrastructure.
- Engage our local community through financial education and community partnerships.
- Increase the Credit Union's return to Members, by increasing dividend rates on Members money market and certificate accounts.
- Increase Credit Union membership, through strategic partnerships and field of membership expansion.
- Create an outreach program to better serve the underserved and unbanked in Orange County.

Community involvement is an important facet of our culture. We are proud of and excited about our efforts supporting our local communities through our Helping Hands employee volunteer initiative. Highlights from 2021 include:

- Eagle's annual scholarship program provided \$4,000 scholarships to four members attending four-year colleges.

- Stamp Out Hunger The pandemic paused the post office's food drive, which Eagle is a major supporter of; the Credit Union made financial donations to our local food banks and donated supplies to support our community. • Dedicated Eagle employees volunteered for a wide variety of non-profit activities within our local community, including serving veterans groups, shelters, child health organizations and a variety of food distribution operations. • CHOC Walk- While the CHOC walk was a virtual event this year, Eagle donated \$6,000 to the hospital on behalf of our Members and team.

Thank you for your loyalty and Membership with Eagle Community Credit Union. We appreciate our committed and engaged employees who work hard every day to enhance the value of your Membership, maintain our financial strength, and support our local communities.

As Eagle enters its 85th year of operations, we look forward to continued success and enhancing the products and services offered as we strive to improve the financial wellbeing of our Members.




